Many adult patrons each year take advantage of participating in the **Adult Winter and Summer Reading Programs**. Friends provide the reading logs, sign-up incentives and gift certificates to numerous local businesses.

Friends sponsors HPL's much anticipated **Children and Teen Summer Reading Program**. Hundreds of young library patrons log their summer reading to earn recognition for their efforts. Prizes, coupons and tickets to various local venues and activities are supported by Friends.

Friends' **Children's Programming** brings to the library diverse entertainment each calendar year, on a wide range of topics, from science to art, local history to dance, theatre, and author visits. These programs are geared towards ages K-6 and are always **free**.

The Annual Friends Book Sale is held the first weekend in August.

Friends are also proud to present exceptional cultural and historical programs as part of **Adult Programming** each year from September through May.

The group also hosts a renowned author during **National Library Week**. This year (2020) marks the **22nd Annual** event of its type. Past authors who have appeared at the library include: Geraldine Brooks, Jodi Picoult, Joyce Carol Oates, Lisa Scottoline, Richard Russo, Chris Bohjalian, Ann Patchett, and Elizabeth Strout. This year's Guest Author is *Lisa Wingate*. All of these events are free of charge as well.

Library on Wheels is a free service offered by the Friends of the Hershey Public Library. Volunteers deliver books, audio books, and other materials to residents of Derry Township who are homebound or would find it physically difficult to come to the library.
